- Check out by 11am on day of departure.
- Fishing is available from 9am on day of arrival.
- Fishing is available until 8pm on day of departure.
- Prices include Fishing, Chalet accommodation, Electricity and use of the BBQ Area (unless otherwise stated).
- To fish you must hold a fishing permit and abide by the Angling rules for these lakes.
- No responsibility accepted for loss of, or damage of any articles or valuables.
- No responsibility accepted for any injury however sustained.
- Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
- Bed Lined is supplied, however please bring your own towels.

<u>Rules</u>

- All litter to be removed from the venue, do not leave bait on banks, or cigarette ends by swims
- We are a catch and release fishery. No fish to be taken away under any circumstance
- Night anglers on Beech Pool and Spring Pool must use proper fishing shelters, umbrellas or bivvies
- Please approach waters by authorized footpaths only
- Dogs must be kept under control at all times, kept on leads and cleaned up after.
- No open fires or BBQs around lakes
- No guns (including air guns) or any other means of trapping game to be in member's possession
- Anglers must be in possession of a valid rod licence
- Micro barbed or barbless hooks only
- All anglers must abide by Environmental Agency Regulations
- A maximum of two rods may be used to fished at any one time
- No freshwater live or dead baits
- No baited rod to be left unattended at any time
- Any angler will not fish further than the middle of the water
- All anglers must use suitable unhooking mats minimum 2ft x 4ft (available for hire).
- Fish can only be lifted to a maximum of 8inches off the ground for photos and to be promptly replaced back into the water
- Bait boats can be used but must not encroach on other swims
- Keep noise to a minimum, this includes bite alarms, radios
- All anglers must use suitable landing nets (available for hire)
- Any persons under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult 21 or over
- Do not fish further than the middle of the water if the opposite swim is occupied
- Torches to be used sensibly at dawn and dusk to not cause a nuisance to residents
- No Driving on the grass areas
- Gated areas must be kept closed

The above rules are there to protect the welfare of our Anglers and our Fish Stocks, failure to comply with the rules of the fishery will result on your removal from the premises. Thank you for your cooperation.
